Please send claims for all cups and trophies, with the exception of the Becky Trophy and Hallbent Trophy, with the points collated and full details of the events at which they were awarded, to the Hon Secretary, Mrs S Henesey, by 14th February.

Becky Trophy

(Awarded to the Top Flatcoated Retriever in the Show Ring in the year)

Points System:

Challenge Certificate:	3 Points
Reserve Challenge Certificate:	2 Points
First Prize at a Championship Show (Breed Classes only):	1 Point

Hallbent Trophy

(Awarded to the Top Flatcoated Retriever Puppy in the Show Ring in the Year)

Points System:

Best Puppy in Breed:	1 Point
First Prize at a Championship Show (MP and P Classes only)	1 Point

Sally Trophy

(Awarded to the Top Flatcoated Retriever Veteran in the Show Ring in the Year)

Points System:

Best Veteran in Breed:	1 Point
First Prize at a Championship Show (V Classes only)	1 Point

1. All points must be gained from Breed Classes only.
2. Only one show will count for collation in any one day.
3. All classes must have a minimum of three dogs entered and present to qualify for collation.

4. Any dog entered and present in any other class will be classed as present whether withdrawn or not from the relevant class.
